## Primary Power!

Politics has never been more partisan than it is right now, making Primary Elections even more impactful. During the Primary, each party selects its top candidates to be on November's General Election ballot.

**Help shape the direction of the Democratic party by voting in the Primary!**

Too few voters in either party turn out for Primary Elections, which means that the vote of each person who does has more power. If you want your party to be more reflective of your values, you need to vote in the Primary.

Hempfield has 12,365 registered Democrats, but in last year's Primary, only 3,468 of them voted. That's only a 28% turnout.

When you vote in this May's Primary, you'll help to select the Democratic candidate for U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative, Governor, Lieutenant Governor, as well as Representatives to the State Assembly.

At a very local level, you'll also determine which Democrats will serve as your voting precinct's Committee People. Every voting precinct can have two.

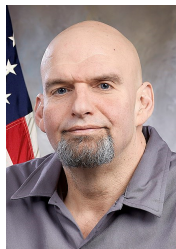

PA voters can vote in person or by mail in the Primary Election, but they must observe these deadlines:

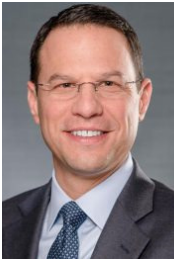
**May 2** - Last day to register to vote
